

Navigation Level 1 – Map Reading Relay

This fulfils Cub Navigation Level 1, Criteria 5: Use a map during an outdoor activity.

- Each Six sits in a line (relay race style) at one end of the field.
- A Map of Woodhouse Park is laid at the other end of the field (one for each Six)
- The following Questions are asked in turn (privately to each six – but same for each six)
Start all sixes at the same time
- The front cub runs to the map, without touching the map (covid!), finds the answer, runs back to tell the leader who instructs the next cub
- First six to return all correct answers wins. Or (with limited time) The six with the most correct answers after 5 minutes wins.
- If we tell you the grid reference, then you find that place on the map, then find the symbol, then interpret the symbol using the Legend.
- If we ask you to locate an item, then find that item on the Legend, then find that item on the map and work out it's grid reference.

8. What is the grid reference of Lovell Centre (Buildings)	E8
9. What is the grid reference of the log pile	H6

12. What is the grid reference of the Archery Range	H9
13. What is 2 squares due south of the Tented Village	Campfire Circle
